The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is pleased to announce a Telemark style Holiday Sending Basket class with Jan Boettcher. We will be painting an original design newly created by Jan. Our project piece will be a sending basket designed and made by Roger Boettcher using inspiration from the sending basket pictured here. This class is for all students with at least one previous rosemaling class who want to paint a lovely holiday gift, for yourself or for another.

The class will be in 5 Zoom sessions:  
Friday, November 3, 6:00 – 9:00PM,

Saturday, Nov. 4, 9AM – Noon and 1 - 4PM, and Sunday, Nov. 5, 9AM – Noon and 1 – 4PM. This a total of 15 hours. All sessions are listed in Central time.

### **TEACHER BIOGRAPHY:**

Jan began her journey into the Norwegian folk art of Rosemaling in 1980. Her Grandmother's family is from the Valdres Valley of Norway. She has taken classes both in Norway and here in the U.S. from Norwegian painters as well as American teachers. Jan currently paints about 12 different styles of Rosemaling along with "nisse" (gnome) painting. She has won numerous awards from clubs, organizations, and the Vesterheim Norwegian American Museum in Decorah, Iowa. Jan was juried into the Indiana Artisan organization in 2011 and has taken part in the Indiana Artisan Marketplace each year since. Being an Indiana Artisan has been a source of pride and she was added to the Indiana Artisan Advisory Board serving through early 2019.

Jan teaches Rosemaling in her home studio, which is in Thorntown, IN. She gives private lessons and she travel teaches at different clubs and organizations. She demonstrates her art, as well as gives talks about this beautiful art and its history to clubs and organizations. She is also available for Zoom classes. She has taught at the Annual Convention for the Society of Decorative Painters and for the Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association.

Jan and her husband have owned and operated Turn of the Century Wood Products ([www.turnofthecentury-in.com](http://www.turnofthecentury-in.com), [www.etsy.com/shop/TurnofthecenturyShop](http://www.etsy.com/shop/TurnofthecenturyShop)) in Thorntown, IN since 2002. - Level: All students with at least one previous rosemailing class. Backgrounding and antiquing will need to be done by student prior to class.
- Schedule: 15 hours total - Friday, November 3, 6:00 – 9:00PM, Saturday, Nov. 4, 9AM – Noon & 1 - 4PM, and Sunday, Nov. 5, 9 – Noon & 1 – 4PM. All sessions are listed in Central time.
