

Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association Class Announcement Os 3-Legged Doll Chair with Lois Mueller

The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is excited to announce our first 2024 class. Lois Mueller will be teaching a Zoom class in the Os style of Per Lysne this coming February. Our project piece will be a miniature three-legged chair with an original design newly created by Lois, shown here. Inspiration photos of Per Lysne's work are shown at the bottom of this page. He often painted on an off-white or light-yellow background but also used a few other colors such as black, red earth (rustic red), a grayish green, and Lois recently saw a chair in a burgundy color. Lois encourages you to select a color that goes with your doll. Palettes for different color backgrounds will be sent with the supply list that comes with your registration confirmation. The class will be in four Zoom sessions: Saturday, February 24, 9AM – Noon and 1 - 4PM, and Sunday, February 25, 9AM – Noon and 1 – 4PM. This a total of 12 hours. All sessions are listed in Central time.



This Zoom class is for rosemaling students who are interested in exploring this lovely style of rosemaling in a miniature form. Students will need to know their strokes and independently prepare their woodenware prior to class. The INRA recommends the class for those at the intermediate painting level and up but advanced beginners sure of their skills are welcome to join in. Lois will be teaching the class in acrylics. She is an experienced oil painter and oil painters are welcome in this class.

Our project piece will fit an 18-inch doll, such as an American Girl doll. Lois is the past President of Rosemaling Coast to Coast. In addition to the many classes Lois teaches, she and her husband, Ron, own Nordic Designs of Wisconsin which offers jewelry that uses stones from the Scandinavian countries, books, packets, and woodenware.
