Rosemaling Basic Techniques with Julie Anderson



The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is excited to have Julie Anderson teach a Rosemaling Basic Techniques class for four weeks in February & March, 2024, via Zoom. This class is open to anyone who wants to learn to do rosemaling or improve their painting skills. This class is designed to cover essential skills to take a project class. Class instruction will include lecture, demonstration, painting time, and individual feedback. It will cover supplies, wood surface preparation, backgrounding and pattern transfer, strokework, line work, basic color mixing, lettering, decorative techniques for borders, glazing and finishing your piece. Students may paint with acrylic or oil paints. Class sessions will be held Thursdays: 2/29, 3/7, 3/14 and 3/21, from 6:30 – 9pm, Central.

A supply list will be sent by email with confirmation of registration. Class materials will be available via Google Drive to enrolled students prior to the first night of class. This is not a project class. Students may paint on practice boards or paper using the medium of their choice. Options will be discussed in the supply list. Class registration will end when the class is full.

Bio for Julie Anderson:

I have been teaching Rosemaling since 1998 and love to share Rosemaling with others and be part of the Rosemaling community. In the fall of 2020, I started teaching virtually. I teach mainly in the Hallingdal, Telemark and Os styles with a focus on techniques and helping students learn how to interpret old work, color, design and ways to express themselves in their painting. However, I paint and have taught other styles of folk art, such as Swedish Dalarnalning/Kurbits and German Bauernmalerei, and have studied with American, Norwegian and Swedish artists who paint these styles.
