

INRA Rogaland Bowl Class with Trudy Peach



The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is excited to have Trudy Peach, VGM, of Buffalo, Minnesota, teach a Rogaland style project class on July 12 & 13, 2024, via Zoom.

Rogaland is located on the west coast of Norway, north of the Vest Agder area, and was influenced by painters from that area as well. This shallow bowl is designed from the top of an 1800's Rogaland trunk. The design may be referred to as "Old Rogaland" as there is little shading in the flowers. There is the standard bonnet-lily flower and tulip used in Rogaland, and also a two-toned simple leaf flower similar to what is found in the Vest Agder area. This piece looks very simple, but is a bit more complicated to paint than meets the eye. It is fun to explore the differences in Rogaland styles.

The project piece suggested is a 12" shallow bowl from Tim Montzka. Class instruction will include demonstration, open painting time, and individual feedback. The class project will be demonstrated in oils. This class is recommended for intermediate and advanced level painters. Class sessions will be held on Friday, 6:30 – 8:30PM, and Saturday, 9AM-12:00PM and 1:00-4PM with an hour for lunch (Central Time).

Please order a 12" shallow bowl from Tim Montzka by using the contact page on the Montzka Woodworking, Inc. website, <https://montzkawoodworking.com/> or by calling (651) 464-5847.

Students must order their woodenware by June 17 to allow for creation and shipment. Please order your woodenware early. Students not ordering woodenware by June 17 may use practice boards in class. These bowls retail for \$25.95. Please mention it's for Trudy's INRA class to receive a 10% discount. Please order as soon as you are able to guarantee arrival in time for backgrounding your bowl.

INRA members will have one week for advanced registration for this class starting today. Information about the class will be available on the INRA website and Facebook page as well as rosemalingleases.com for the public starting May 27. Class registration will end when the class is full.

A supply list will be sent by email with confirmation of registration. Pattern packets will be sent by email to enrolled students at the beginning of July. The Zoom link will be sent the week of class.



About the Artist Trudy Peach

Trudy Peach grew up in NW Wisconsin and has been rosemaling for over 40 years. She started by taking classes at the Vo-Tech in Milwaukee, WI. and upon moving to the Minneapolis area Trudy took community education classes prior to attending Vesterheim classes. She has taken courses from many Norwegian and American artists and became a Vesterheim Gold Medalist in 1986. She is also a Certified Decorative Artist with the Society of Decorative Painters, having received her CDA in 1990. Trudy concentrates her painting styles on Norway's west coast rosemaling styles - Rogaland, Os, and Agder. She prefers to use the term "Agder Style" to include Vest Agder, Aust Agder, and Setesdal. There are many crossovers in flower forms, color, line work, etc., in these districts. Trudy studies old rosemaling pieces, photos, folios, books, etc. to help influence her designs. She has taught classes throughout the United States in all three styles. Her work has been in several publications, including the *Rosemalers' Cookbook*, *Viking* magazine and *Decorative Artists* magazine, as well as the books *Norwegian Folk Art*, *The Migration of a Tradition* by Marion Nelson and *Rosemaling in the Upper Midwest* by Phillip Martin. She has had pieces on tour in Norway through the Vesterheim Museum. Trudy enjoys creating new designs and spending time with other rosemalers.

Dates/Class Schedule: July 12 and 13 – Friday, 6:30 – 8:30PM, and Saturday, 9AM-12:00PM and 1:00-4PM with an hour for lunch (Central Time).

Level: Intermediate and up. Students should know how to handle their brushes and, while we will mix colors in class, students should have knowledge of color mixing to some degree. Students must sand, background, and seal their painting surface and practice boards, plus transfer the design to their backgrounded painting surfaces and practice boards, on their own prior to class.

Class Fee: \$95 for INRA members or \$110 for nonmembers, which covers \$15 for 2024 membership to INRA)

This class will have a 6-student minimum and 14-student maximum, no refunds unless place is filled by another student from a waiting list. INRA classes are designed for real-time interaction in each class session and recordings are for those who plan to participate in the live classes.
