## Necklace Pendant Series with Jan Boettcher



The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is pleased to announce a series of rosemaling project classes with Jan Boettcher. Jan has designed a group of necklace pendants showcasing four styles of rosemaling: Raudsaumsmaling, Rogaland, Telemark, and Valdres. Each class stands independent of the others so you can sign up for any one or all as you are able.

The classes are one Zoom session each. They will be held on Thursday evenings from 6:00 – 9:00PM (Central) on the following dates:

July 18 – Raudsaumsmaling  
August 1 – Rogaland

August 15 – Telemark  
August 29 – Valdres



The classes are for all students with at least one rosemaling class experience. Students will need to background their pendant(s) prior to each class. Jan will cover each style's history and defining characteristics as she demonstrates the project's strokes and linework in each class.

The supply list(s) will be sent with your class registration. ### TEACHER BIOGRAPHY:



Jan began her journey into the Norwegian folk art of Rosemaling in 1980. Her grandmother's family is from the Valdres Valley of Norway. She has taken classes here in the U.S. and in Norway. Jan currently paints about 12 different styles of rosemaling. She has won numerous awards from clubs, organizations, and the Vesterheim Norwegian American Museum in Decorah, Iowa. Being an Indiana Artisan has been a source of pride and she was added to the Indiana Artisan Advisory Board serving through early 2019. Jan teaches rosemaling both in-person and virtually, through classes for various groups and private lessons.

Jan and her husband, Roger, have owned and operated Turn of the Century Wood Products ([www.etsy.com/shop/TurnofthecenturyShop](http://www.etsy.com/shop/TurnofthecenturyShop)) in Thorntown, Indiana, since 2002. Jan feels that she has been very blessed to be able to meet wonderful people while enjoying and sharing her love of this beautiful art from Norway!
