TEACHER BIOGRAPHY:

Jan began her journey into the Norwegian folk art of Rosemaling in 1980. Her Grandmother's family is from the Valdres Valley of Norway. She has taken classes both in Norway and here in the U.S. from Norwegian painters as well as American teachers. Jan currently paints about 12 different styles of Rosemaling along with "nisse" (gnome) painting. She has won numerous awards from clubs, organizations, and the Vesterheim Norwegian American Museum in Decorah, lowa. Jan was juried into the Indiana Artisan organization in 2011 and has taken part in the Indiana Artisan Marketplace each year since. Being an Indiana



Artisan has been a source of pride and she was added to the Indiana Artisan Advisory Board serving through early 2019.

Jan teaches Rosemaling in her home studio, which is in Thorntown, IN. She gives private lessons and she travel teaches at different clubs and organizations. She demonstrates her art, as well as gives talks about this beautiful art and its history to clubs and organizations. She is also available for Zoom classes. She has taught at the Annual Convention for the Society of Decorative Painters and for the Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association.
