Beginner Coaster Set Class with Kirstin Lewis

The Illinois Norsk Rosemalers Association is pleased to announce an upcoming online Beginner Coaster Project class. Kirstin Lewis will be teaching a six-night Zoom class on July 1-3 & 8-10, 2025. The INRA recommends this Zoom class for artists who are interested in exploring the different styles of the Norwegian folk art of rosemaling. Kirstin will be teaching the class in oils; independent acrylic painters are welcome.

In this class students will be learning about the following 6 styles of rosemaling; Valdres, Telemark, Hallingdal, Os, Trondelag, and Rogaland. You will learn about stylistic differences and get to paint a coaster for each type.



The coaster set is available from [Hobby Lobby](https://www.hobbylobby.com). Please be aware of delivery dates when ordering/purchasing your supplies. The INRA recommends delivery dates a week prior to the first day of class.

The class will be in six Zoom sessions: Tuesday, 7/1, Wednesday 7/2 and Thursday 7/3, and the following week, Tuesday, 7/8, Wednesday 7/9 and Thursday 7/10, from 6:30 – 8:30pm, Central time. This a total of 12 hours of instruction.



TEACHER BIOGRAPHY: Kirstin's rosemaling journey began with inspiration from her mother, Jennifer Lewis, who practiced rosemaling during Kirstin's childhood. Many of Jen's pieces were displayed throughout their home. After moving back to Colorado with her husband, who was in the military, Kirstin convinced her mom to pick up the brushes again and join her in a local class at the Sons of Norway, taught by Louise Bath. Kirstin has been practicing rosemaling since 2015 and began teaching in-person classes in 2021. She has enjoyed learning various styles of rosemaling from Louise Bath and has had the opportunity to take three classes at Vesterheim.

Kirstin recommends the M. Graham brand which is somewhere in the middle of the price range. Information and additional details will be provided on the supply list that will be sent with registration confirmation.

Registration opens May 1st. Registration ends when the class is full. Please complete the registration form on page 3.

SUPPLIES: A supply list will be included with your registration confirmation. Other class information such as patterns, and the Zoom link, will be sent to registered students closer to the class start date.

NOTE: This class will have a 6 student minimum and 12 student maximum, no refunds unless place is filled by another student from a waiting list. INRA classes are designed for real-time interaction in each class session and recordings are for reviewing presented material by those who plan to participate in the live classes. All students are reminded that class recordings and materials are for individual use only and are not to be shared.
